ORDER

ESI Corporation vide decision taken in its 162th Board meeting, it was decided to stop the processing and payment of bills related to the medial care of beneficiaries (treatment bill of empanelled centres, bills of pharmaceutical firms, treatment advances etc.) from 01-04-2015 and entrusted the whole task to the ESIS System. In order to streamline the procedure, adequate powers should be delegated to various level officers of the Insurance Medical Services Department. Subsequently the new development was discussed in the State Executive Committee Meeting and the Committee entrusted the Director of Insurance Medical Services to submit a proposal on this to Government. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance Medical Services forwarded a proposal in this regard to Government for sanction, as per the letter read above.

In the letter, the Director has reported that Director & Joint Director now have the delegated powers to sanction the medical reimbursement bills of Insured Persons without any upper limit. To ensure other payments (payment of empanelled centres, pharmaceutical companies, treatment advance etc.) in a transparent and hassle free manner, as it was done by the Senior State Medical Commissioner earlier, the Director requested to delegate powers to Director/Joint Director to sanction the above said bills without any upper limit.
